

Speak! A Monologue Competition



COMPETITION RULES AND GUIDELINES

ENTRY RULES

All eligible participants must be 18 years old and up. High school students are not permitted. Competition application is required and can be found at mpac-arts.org. Application must be completed in full.

ENTRY FEE

A \$10.00 non-refundable fee is required for participant entry. Fees cover submission and data processing.

VIDEO SUBMISSION

Monologues can be no longer than 1 minute 30 seconds in length.

Selection type can include Comedy, Drama, Classical, or Original work. Extreme vulgar language and/or sexual content is not permitted.

Participant should also state Name, Age, and Title/Play reference of monologue in video.

No props of any kind will be allowed.

Only one submission per person.

DEADLINE

October 6th 2018. No exceptions. This includes video monologue and entry fee. Submissions are not accepted after the deadline.

The Top 12 competing participants will be selected by October 3rd 2018.

TWO ROUND MONOLOGUE COMPETITION

Top 12 participants should prepare at least two monologues for competition. Performing the submitted video monologue in Round 1 of competition is acceptable.

Monologues can be no longer than 1 minute 30 seconds in length. A 15 second grace period will apply. After the grace period, points are deducted from the performance.

No props of any kind will be allowed. Do overs are not permitted.

Each participant will receive a verbal critique from Judges based on Presentation, Creativity, and Originality. Critique will include performance score using a 0.0 to 10.0 point system.

After score tabulation, the Top 6 will move on to Final Round of the competition. Same rules apply.

Winners Selected! Top 3 participants will be awarded 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place Prizes.
